

Virgin Territory: How I Found My Inner Guadalupe

The Virgin Mary



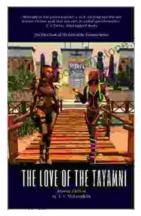
